Leave the M23 at Jcn 10a onto the B2036, at the round about follow signs to Borde Hill Gardens on the Haywards heath Road, straight through Balcombe village which then becomes Stone Hall Lane then Borde Hill lane, stay on this road and pass the viaduct on your right then about 800m on the left up the hill you will see a concrete road this is the entrance to Rivers Wood,
